- ❖ Company mobility: same seat principle (a transfer of registered office Directive?)
- ❖ Privileging sustainable company (meaningful capital base, auditing, company reporting)

2. WHICH FUTURE FOR EUROPEAN COMPANY LAW? SOME PROPOSALS

- ❖ More democracy at the workplace:
 - Upward convergence between EU instruments (e.g.: transfer of undertakings Directive)
 - Horizontal framework on workers' involvement (setting high standards on information, consultation and workers' board level representation) in European company forms.
